

ATTENTION: Hay, Straw, & Pine Needle Producers

Do you produce any kind of hay or straw and ship it out of your county or the state?

Bales of straw and hay, including pine straw, are articles regulated by the State and Federal governments because of the risk they pose of spreading Red Imported Fire Ants (RIFA). The North Carolina Department of Agriculture & Consumer Services (NCDA&CS) has quarantined partially, or in full, 75 out of 100 counties in North Carolina due to the presence of RIFA in cooperation with the USDA's federal quarantine.

Shipping hay or straw out of a quarantined area without a compliance agreement into a non-quarantined county or state **is in violation** of the United States Department of Agriculture's (USDA) federal quarantine on RIFA which the NCDA&CS upholds. NCD&CS Plant Pest Specialists will help you obtain these documents and ensure you are compliant with all State and Federal regulations at no charge.

What should I do if I am a hay/straw producer shipping out of the quarantine and I have never heard of this?

- 1) Locate your county and the specialist for your county on the back of this sheet.
- 2) Please contact that specialist so that they can explain and facilitate the necessary steps to get your operation under a compliance agreement with the NCDA&CS.

Will there be penalties or costs associated with compliance?

- 1) Compliance requires a yearly inspection of your facility and a signed agreement outlining the procedures you will follow to maintain your compliant status.
- 2) There is no charge to the farmer for compliance agreements and no retroactive penalties for previous non-compliance.
- 3) Shipping out of the quarantine without following the required guidelines could result in federal penalties, rejected shipments, shipping delays, and potential federal investigation by USDA-APHIS-PPQ.


