The EFNEP PA delivers nutrition education and related subject matter. The individual in this position will:

- market the program within the assigned area,
- recruit and enroll income-eligible adult and/or school-aged youth participants into the program,
- make regular teaching visits to enrollees in group settings,
- teach basic principles of nutrition and demonstrate food preparation skills,
- submit required program records,
- build partnerships with community-based organizations and schools
- collaborate with local Cooperative Extension staff and agencies,
- and assist with securing program resources.

### Requirements

Minimum:

- A high-school diploma or equivalent.
- Bilingual with English and Spanish proficiency in both written and oral communication.

Preferred:

- Knowledge of the community and social service programs for limited resource families;
- Experience teaching and/or working with limited resource adults; and/or nutrition education experience;
